Opening Prayer/Reflection: Fr. Stephen led the opening prayer.

Welcome/Acceptance of March 21 Meeting Minutes: Yolande asked for the acceptance of the March meeting minutes and they were accepted unanimously.

Pastor Report: Fr. Stephen gave the Pastor Report, saying that the Easter services were all beautiful celebrations despite the restriction and numbers in attendance. Every available spot was taken at each Mass. The outdoor Mass was a huge success and very much appreciated by those who still feel uncomfortable attending. The Government announced loosening of restrictions but what does that mean for us? We still need to wear masks and adhere to the 6' separation. Maybe we call it Flowers on Wheels. We need to plant flowers in our community garden (Margot volunteered) and Yolande asked that we all save our vases for this ministry. Criona volunteered to help with the Community garden.

Deb volunteered to reach out to the Eucharistic Ministers and the Adult Choir.
