In the early Church, people wanting to enter the community of believers would change their names at Baptism. This change symbolized their willingness to “put on Christ”, something that effected ALL aspects of their lives, including what they were called.

At Baptism, you were given a name by your parents. As you approach the Sacrament of Confirmation, you are given the opportunity to select another name – one of YOUR choosing. This “Confirmation name” is not a legal name. Rather, it’s a symbolic action that connects you with a saint whom you admire or would like to imitate. Your “Confirmation name” can be a saint, (Michael, Theresa, etc.), Biblical character (Sarah, Adam, etc.) or Christian virtue (Faith, Hope, etc.). This name connects you in a special way to those believers of long ago.

Each candidate must submit a biography of his/her chosen name, as well as the reasons why you have chosen the name. Please be certain to complete BOTH SIDES of this form, or, if you wish, you may type the report on a separate paper (as long as you include all the information that is requested on this form.
